OPTION CONTINUE BROWSING

CONFIGURATION OF THE COOKIE SYSTEM:

- The banner must be inserted in a clearly visible place that does not go unnoticed by the user.
- The “continue browsing” mode will not be valid if it includes an explicit acceptance mechanism, such as check boxes or acceptance buttons. It will only be valid if the user “continues browsing”.
- The banner will disappear when the user “continues browsing”.
- *Cookies* must not be installed until the user “continues browsing”.
- Users may withdraw consent at any time by accessing the Cookies policy.
- The Cookies policy will enable a Configuration Panel where users can choose whether to **accept** or **reject** cookies.
- It shall be as easy to withdraw as to give consent.

CONFIGURATION OF THE “CONTINUE BROWSING» MODE

«Continue browsing» shall be considered valid consent when the user performs any of the following actions:

- Browsing to another section of the website or clicking on any link other than the Cookies policy.
- Using the scroll bar, as long as the information about cookies is visible without using it.
- Closing the banner’s warning.
- On smartphones or tablets:
 - Sliding the screen and accessing content.
 - Prior information to the user of the meaning of a sufficiently unequivocal concrete action:
 - Waving in front of a smart camera.
 - Rotating a smartphone clockwise.
 - Moving a smartphone by making the shape of an eight.
 - Certain mouse movements.
 - Pressing specific keys.

“Continue browsing” will not be considered valid consent for:

- The fact of simply looking at the screen.
- Moving the mouse.
- Pressing a key.
